

Installation Instructions



DETERMINE INSTALLATION PREFERENCES

This faucet can be installed as 4 hole installation with the escutcheon or as 2 hole installation with flange.

Flange Installation:


- 1. Shut off water supplies & remove old faucet.
- 2. Before installation, ensure the flange is placed on the bottom of the new faucet assembly.
- 3. Insert faucet body through the hole in the flange.

Escutcheon Installation:


- 1. Shut off water supplies & remove old faucet.
- 2. Screw the bolts into the escutcheon (a).
- 3. Ensure the gasket is pressed into the escutcheon before the escutcheon is installed over the three holes in the sink (b).
- 4. From underneath the sink, hand tighten the mounting nuts. Do not overtighten (c).
- 5. Insert faucet body through the hole in escutcheon.


INSTALL THE FAUCET

- 1. Install the plastic washer (a) and metal washer (b) onto the threaded mounting shank (c). Thread the nut onto the mounting shank. Lock the nut into position by tightening the screws. Do not overtighten.
- 2. Push the quick connector firmly upward and attach it to the receiving block (d). Pull down moderately to ensure the connection has been made. If it is necessary to remove the quick connector, squeeze the tabs on the quick connector and then pull down to disconnect.
- 3. After connecting the hose, install the weights at the point of the hose marking "weights here" (e).



ESCUTCHEON INSTALLATION OPTION





Installation Instructions

INSTALL THE SOAP DISPENSER

- 1. Insert the body assembly through the selected hole in the sink (a).
- 2. Secure the body assembly to the sink with the nut.
- From under the sink, screw the bottle onto the body 3. assembly shank.
- Insert the pump down into the body assembly. 4.




CONNECT THE WATER


1. Thread the nut on the supply line onto the outlet of the water supply valve and tighten with a wrench. Do not overtighten.

IMPORTANT: The hot side inlet tube is indicated by a label. Avoid twisting wires together or placing the wires close to each other and damaging.

FINISHING

- 1. After installation is completed, turn on the hot and cold water supplies. Check for leaks.
- 2. Pull the hose assembly out of the spout and remove the spray head by unscrewing it from the hose in a counterclockwise direction. Be sure to hold the end of the hose down into the sink and turn the faucet on to the warm position where it mixes hot and cold water.
- Flush the water lines for one minute. This flushes 3. away any debris that could cause damage to internal parts.
- 4. Check for leaks. Re-tighten any connections if necessary, but do not overtighten.
- 5. Reinstall the spray head by hand tightening it back onto the spray hose.









Care & Maintenance

RECOMMENDED CLEANERS

For stains or light scratches, we suggest a mildly aggressive cleaner. You can also try a paste of baking soda and water, but be sure to rinse well and dry.

For stubborn stains and more noticeable scratches, we suggest a more aggressive cleaner such as Bar Keeper's Friend©. For extremely stubborn stains, you may also try to use a Scotch-Brite[™] Pad. When using any of these cleaners, it is critical that you rub in the direction of the grain lines, rinse completely and towel dry.

SUGGESTED MAINTENANCE

Inspect water hose supply lines monthly for abrasions to the lines and any bulges that could indicate weakness to the lines. Clean regularly to prevent the build up of calcification on the faucet.

DURABILITY AND CAUTION

- Don't allow soap or other household cleansers to dry on the surface of the linear faucet. Most brands contain chemical additives which will affect the original finish.
- · Don't use a steam cleaner as high temperatures can damage your faucet.
- Don't use solutions of chlorine bleach and water to clean the faucet. Chlorides, which are found in most soaps, detergents, bleaches, and cleansers, are very aggressive to stainless steel. If left too long, they can cause surface pitting.
- Don't use a steel wool pad to clean your faucet. If a more abrasive product is needed, use a green Scotch-Brite[™] pad, being sure to rub in the direction of the satin finish lines. Steel wool pads have a tendency to break apart and small particles of steel can become embedded in the surface of the linear drain. The steel particles will rust and will give the appearance that the faucet itself is rusting.
